

# CANYAMEL GOLF



## Local rules



Unlike many sports, golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

In terms of golf's environment, Canyamel's Course and House Rules are about showing respect for the course and the work that has been put in to create it. It is about making sure that the game is played safely and that others on the course are able to enjoy the round as much as you.

**Please observe the following Rules while playing at Canyamel:**

- 1. Before starting, it is necessary to check in at the reception desk / pro-shop to book or confirm your tee time. Our staff will as well provide further information regarding course conditions and daily circumstances.**
- 2. Tee times are spaced at an interval of 10 minutes. Bookings can be made personally, by phone, per e-mail or via internet. Full names and handicaps of all players must be stated. All guests and members with bookings must register at the reception desk / pro-Shop at least 10 minutes prior to their tee time. In the event that this is not done, the booked tee time will expire. Should players tee off without registering or miss a tee time unexcused, the respective players will not be entitled to make bookings for a period of 4 weeks.**
- 3. Member badges and greenfee tags must be displayed clearly visible on the golf bag.**
- 4. Canyamel Golf welcomes guests who are members of accredited golf clubs and in possession of a valid club ID card. The maximum handicap is 36 for men and 45 for women. Members of Canyamel Golf are allowed to play, having obtained the club permit.**
- 5. A game of golf always starts at the tee of Hole 1. Deviations need to be confirmed by the reception desk or the golf course marshal.**
- 6. Players should not hit the ball or enter the tee box until the flight in front is out of range.**
- 7. Always try to keep pace with the group ahead of you. If space opens in front of you, allow a faster group to play through. Do not spend more than 5 minutes searching for a lost ball. If there is a group behind you ready to play, let this group pass before you start looking for your ball.**
- 8. Every player must carry along his own equipment. Rental clubs, if required, are available in the pro-shop. Please respect our dress code, on the course and in the club house. Collarless shirts and jeans are not permitted. Please be aware that only soft spikes are permitted on the golf course.**
- 9. Players aged 16 and under are considered as juniors, special rates apply.**
- 10. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult on the golf course and in the restaurant. Due to security reasons infants or baby buggies are not allowed on the golf course.**



11. **Dogs are not allowed at Canyamel Golf.**
12. **In the bunker, after hitting your shot, rake the area you played from, as well as all your footprints and any others within reach. Rakes should be left in the bunker. Replace your divots and step them into place. On the green please repair pitch marks and other damages that may have been caused by you or other players. When practicing your swing, never swing in the direction of another player. No practice swings on the tee. When playing on or near the green, leave your bags or carts in such a position as will enable quick movement off the green and towards the next tee. After removing the flagstick lay it down carefully without doing any damage to the green. Don't step within a one-foot radius of the cup when removing the ball – which as well should be done carefully and without using the putter head.**
13. **Range balls may only be used on practice grounds (driving range, chipping area and practice bunkers) and may not to be played on the golf course or putting greens. Members and Guests playing range balls on the course will be liable to immediate suspension.**
14. **Golf carts are available for rent at the reception desk / pro-shop. In so far as possible, carts shall be kept to the designated pathways. Do not drive the cart close to a green (watch the signs). The cart key shall be returned to the reception desk / pro-shop immediately after the round of golf. Under no circumstances are guests and members allowed to take a cart key with them when leaving the golf premises. The player renting the cart is responsible for its specified, safe and considerate usage.**
15. **On the driving range, please play from designated mats or selected roped off areas. Be aware of those around you and any maintenance personnel on the range. Maintain a safe distance from other players and do not walk in front of the hitting line. Please show consideration for other players and do not disturb them by talking or making any unnecessary noise.**
16. **Do not dispose of waste (paper, cigarettes, bottles, etc.) on the course. Please use the bins provided at every teeing ground.**
17. **It is not allowed to remove bath towels from the locker rooms.**
18. **The Committee has established pace of play guidelines for all players to follow. A round of golf for a foursome should not exceed 4 ½ hours.**

These rules are mandatory and valid until recalled.

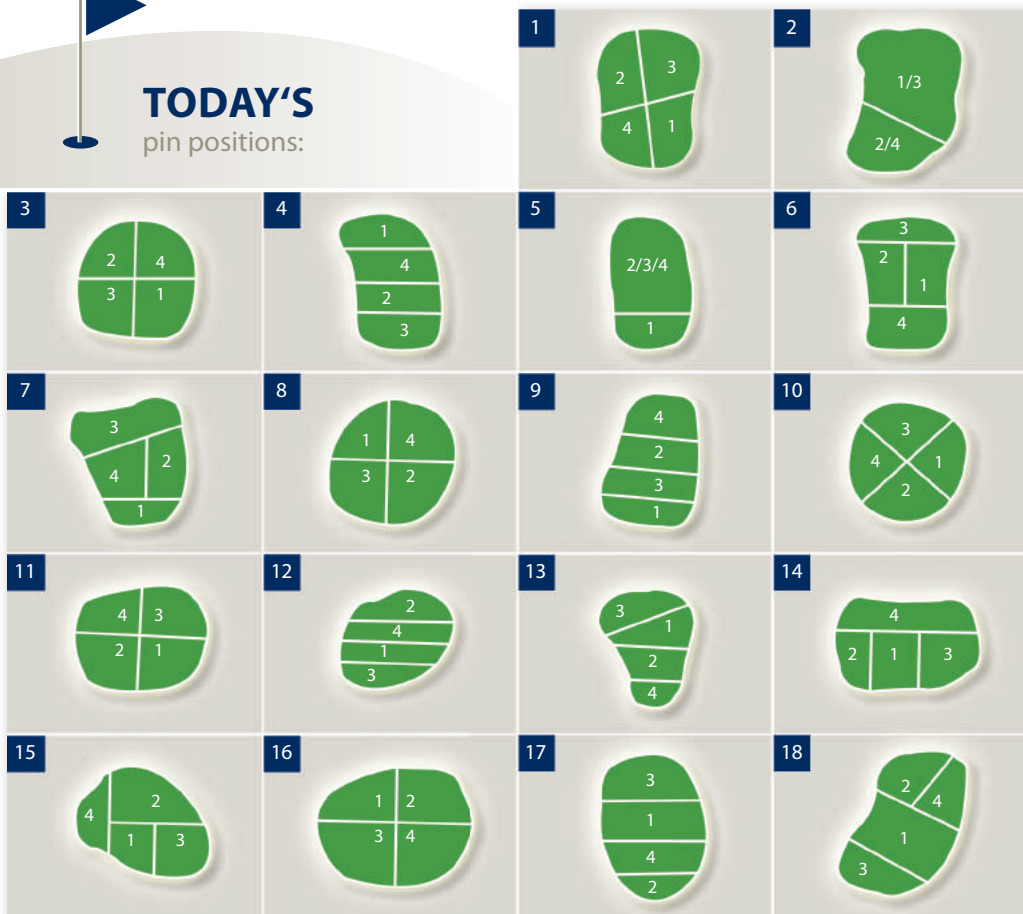
